Tim -

I have reviewed the RTCs and proposed changes and have the following concerns:

Response to Comment #2 -

The response does not give any additional details as requested. In particular, please include a description of a standard filter bag (i.e. what is the filtering material, perhaps include a photo). Also, please include locations of possible discharge areas (depiction on a figure may be helpful). There is additional language in a letter addressed to Carl Thomas (DEQ) from Tim Reisch (NAVFAC) dated 10-26-10 that may be pertinent to include, "It (referring to nuisance water) will be discharged through a filter bag, removing entrained sediment and debris, to the ground in vegetated, level upland areas. Discharging to the upland areas will increase infiltration and reduce the likelihood of the discharge from entering the wetland and Blows Creek."

Response to Comment #3 -

Please include the depth of subsurface soil sample locations in the report to support the removal to a depth of 1 foot.

Response to Comment #4 -

Please include the following text (doesn't have to be exact wording) from the response in the report, "If conditions of the wetland following the restoration require regrading, a grading plan, and potentially a separate contract, would be necessary to conduct this work."

Response to Comment #8 -

Please revise sentence to say, "...adjacent to the waste/burnt soil area that present a potential human health or ecological hazard at Site 5..."

All other RTCs are acceptable.
