RECORD OF DECISION FOR INSTALLATION RESTORATION SITE 21, INDUSTRIAL AREA St. Juliens Creek Annex Chesapeake, Virginia

The Department of the Navy Environmental Restoration Program announces a Record of Decision (ROD) for Installation Restoration Program Site 21 at St. Juliens Creek Annex, Chesapeake, Virginia. The ROD documents the remedial action chosen for the site and the basis for selecting the action. Verbal comments received during the public meeting held during the 45-day comment period are documented in the Responsiveness Summary included in the ROD. The Preferred Alternative is groundwater treatment through a two-phase approach: (1) in situ chemical reduction and (2) enhanced reductive dechlorination. The Navy and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency signed the ROD with written concurrence from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality. Final signature on the ROD was received on October 20, 2011.
