
Purpose for Conducting Time Critical Removal Action

**Response to an imminent danger posed
by the munitions items in the LIA to
trespassers and site workers.**

TCRA Objectives

- ❖ Remove all munitions equivalent to or larger than a 20mm projectile present or exposed at the ground surface from 400 acres within the LIA.
- ❖ Reduce risks at sites identified as posing an explosive hazard due to munitions present or partially exposed at the ground surface.


Former VNTR MRS Map



Sites Within the LIA For Performance Of TCRA

- ❖ Surface to air missile west site
- ❖ Naval gunfire target areas
- ❖ Air-to-ground targets
- ❖ Mock runway
- ❖ OB/OD site

Map Of Sites Where TCRA Will Be Conducted



TCRA Approach

- ❖ Vegetation removal ranging from grasses to trees is anticipated for most of the TCRA area
- ❖ A metals detector assisted surface clearance of all 400 acres
- ❖ Record locations and information for all identified munitions and targets
- ❖ Removal of all surface munitions 20mm and greater
- ❖ Demilitarization of all recovered munitions (DoD 4160.21-M-1)

Schedule

- ❖ Site preparations have begun
- ❖ Site specific work plan is in review and expected to be approved in a few weeks
