

**NAVAL FACILITIES ENGINEERING COMMAND
SEABEE 75TH ANNIVERSARY
LOGO CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES**

Introduction:

This document describes the official rules (“Official Rules”) of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command’s Seabee 75th Anniversary Logo Design and Theme Contest (the “Contest”). The object of this contest is to design the official logo and theme for the Seabee 75th Anniversary that will be celebrated in 2017.

Definitions:

“Entry or Entries” means a logo design and theme created by the Entrant for this Contest.

“Entrant or Entrants” means the individual that offers the Entry under the terms of this Contest.

Eligibility:

The Contest is open only to individuals of legal age. The Contest is not open to DoD contractors and non-Federal entities or groups associated with such contractors or entities.

How to Enter:

1. Initial entries must be submitted by email to Seabee75thanniversary@gmail.com. Include “LOGO CONTEST” in the subject line.
2. The deadline for Entries is midnight on January 31, 2016, Eastern Standard Time.
3. Entrants must include a fully executed submission form that includes their full name, mailing address, telephone number, email address and age. Incomplete submission forms and accompanying entries will be rejected.
4. Entrants may submit multiple entries. If submitting multiple entries in one email, Entrant must indicate the number of entries in the body of the email.

Submission Guidelines:

The purpose of the contest is to design a logo and theme for the Seabee 75th Anniversary. The logo and theme will be used in various formats such as online, print, and on merchandise. Therefore, the entry must be easily resized and must be legible in black and white as well as in color.

- Entries must be suitable for public viewing.
- Entries must be a computer-generated design in a JPG, TIF, or PNG format. Hand drawn or other formats are not permitted.
- Entries must be submitted in both color formats (RGB and CMYK).
- The image size of the file must not exceed 1280 x 1024 pixels.

- Entries must be submitted at a resolution of at least 600dpi.
- Entries with halftones or gradients are not permitted.
- Entrants must ensure that their Entries are not in any way similar to existing logos or other copyrighted images.

Entries which do not conform to the Submission Guidelines will be rejected and not considered eligible for judging.

Judging:

Judging is based on the logo and theme that best fulfills the mission of the Seabee 75th Anniversary and creates an image that promotes the purpose of the anniversary events.

The Commander, Naval Facilities Engineering Command will select the winning entry. His decision will be final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

The winning Entry will be announced on the Naval Facilities Engineering Command's website (<http://navfac.navy.mil/seabee75thanniversary>) on March 1, 2016. The winning Entrant will also be notified via email. The Naval Facilities Engineering Command reserves the right to amend this date as required.

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command reserves the right not to select a winner if, in its sole discretion, no suitable entries are received.

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant or Entry at its sole discretion. No correspondence will be entered into.

Legal:

Upon submission, Entrants expressly state the following:

- That his/her Entry is his/her original work, was not created as part of his/her official duties as an officer or employee of the United States Government, and was not created as a work for hire.
- That the Entry is not owned by any other individual or entity.

All Entries will become the property of the Department of the Navy. The winner will be required to sign an agreement assigning all property interests to the Department of the Navy.

By submitting an Entry, all Entrants grant permission for the Department of the Navy to make public and otherwise use his/her name, should they win, for publicity purposes. All publicity will be in accordance with the Department of the Navy Public Affairs Guidance.

The Department of the Navy and the Naval Facilities Engineering Command are not responsible for lost, damaged, late, or never received Entries.
