PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This is a design-build contract to construct a Wounded Warrior headquarters building and recovery center facility. The mission to serve battle wounded marines and their families in their recovery and rehabilitation requires special attention to accessibility, physical therapy, fitness and counseling. The recovery center is designed to meet these special requirements and includes indoor lap and therapy pools, fitness and physical rehabilitation spaces and equipment, rock climbing walls, office and administrative spaces and a ceremonial area for dedications and memorial displays. The headquarters building will include a command suite, offices for HQ functions, a contact/call center, duty rooms, and a mail room. Building construction will include reinforced concrete foundation and floors, structural steel framing, concrete-masonry-unit walls with brick veneer, a standing seam metal roof and covered entrance portico.
