



Notice of Public Information Meeting

Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act, the U.S. Navy is preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) to evaluate alternatives to address the long-term management of the Hammerhead Crane at Naval Support Activity Norfolk Naval Shipyard, Portsmouth, Virginia.

Depending on the alternative selected, the proposed action could result in the Navy either dismantling the Hammerhead Crane or minimally repairing the crane to preserve it as a static, non-functional display for a period of 20 years.

The Navy will hold a public information meeting to provide information about the project and give the public the opportunity to provide comments on the human and natural environmental concerns that should be addressed in the EA. Public information meeting details are as follows:
