Prior to public release or release to DoD or other U.S. government agencies photos must be reviewed and approved by Codes 1700, 100 PAO, 106, and 105 if applicable, and in some cases by NAVSEA, using "Photography Release Form", Appendices 9.12.2 through 9.12.4 and NAVSEA Public Release Form of reference (e), as appropriate.

The applicant understands that the photos (except for public release) shall be initially marked as FOUO, unless a higher classification is required. The storage media e.g. film CD, memory stick, tape and case will also be marked handled and controlled as applicable. Classified images will only be down loaded to an appropriately controlled computer. The photographer's security clearance must meet the level required for photo content.

Cameras on travel to other installations or ship checks must meet the requirements of that activity. As custodian of a camera I will ensure that any other person using that camera also abide by the above.
