- Completed Final Status Survey scans in Survey Unit 5 in Building 2.
- Started Final Status Survey scans in Survey Unit 6 in Building 2.
- Completed weekly security inspections and RMA boundary surveys/sampling.
- Completed weekly Tisch filter collection/change-out.
- Completed removal of CB-1 and 30 feet of associated storm drain pipe from south end of Building 27.
- Started quarterdeck demolition Building 27.
- Completed maps for additional gamma walkover survey areas.

Activities Planned for Next Week:

- Complete quarterdeck demolition Building 27.
- Complete Final Status Survey scans in Survey Unit 6 in Building 2.
- Complete brick wall remediation in 1939 former instrument shop Building 2.
- Complete hotspot removal and (2nd) FSS scans within Survey Units 4 & 5 of Building 2.
- Continue soil hotspot/storm drain removal south of Building 27.
- Start additional gamma walkover surveys.
