This is a US Navy funded cleanup project, following the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act CERCLA, the National Oil and Hazardous Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) (40 Code of Federal Regulations [CFR] 300.5) and substantive requirements of the Washington State Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA, Washington Administrative Code 173-340-515).

- Performed reference background survey of building 47.
- Shipped remaining soil samples collected in outside areas to the lab for analysis.
- Completed installation of pipe for temporary roof drainage system at building 27.
- Completed clearing of vegetation within the outside area adjacent to building 27.
- Started gamma walkover of outside area adjacent to building 27.
- Completed initial asbestos and lead assessment survey in building 27.
- Completed weekly RMA boundary survey.
- Completed weekly Tisch air filter collection.
- Completed outgoing survey for Scissor Lift used for temporary drainage pipe installation.

Activities Planned for Next Week:

- Continue gamma walkover surveys.
- Start asbestos and lead sample collection in building 27.
- Complete reference background survey of building 47.
- Begin reacquiring areas of elevated contamination in Building 2 identified in the RI.
