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NAVY'S \$30M WESTSOUND BOSC AWARDED

SILVERDALE, Wash. – Naval Facilities Engineering Command Northwest announced today that through the competitive bidding process Chugach Federal Solutions, Inc., of Anchorage was awarded a \$30 million BOSC base year contract.

The West Sound Base Operating Support Contract takes effect on June 1, 2014 and consists of one base year and up to four option years. If all option years are renewed, the total contract has a value of more than \$275 million.

The contractor was chosen using Best Value Source Selection procurement which includes price and non-price factors which when combined constitutes a best value to the government. The objective was to select a contractor whose overall proposal demonstrated the best value to the government based upon stated criteria.

The work to be performed includes operation and maintenance of security operations and services, fire & emergency services, management of both medical and non-medical facilities as well as pest control services base support vehicle and equipment services, environmental services, and utility services. The work will be performed at Naval installations located in Clallam, Jefferson and Kitsap counties.
