**Programmatic Agreement (PA) Memo Related to a Military Relocation Project is
Open for Public Comments Through Jan. 23**

PEARL HARBOR-HICKAM – Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Pacific announced today the start of a 45-day public comment period for the Department of Defense Plan (DoD) to resolve adverse effects associated with Project J-001B: Finegayan Utilities and Site Improvements Phase 1 (PA Memo #2).

Comments are being accepted through Jan. 23, 2015 (Chamorro Standard Time), and may be submitted by email to criwebcomment@navy.mil.

J-001B proposes the first phase of required utilities and site improvements at Naval Base Guam Telecommunications Site (NBGTS), should this area be the selected alternative for construction of a cantonment area to support the Guam and Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) Military Relocation. This project proposes to conduct construction and associated efforts, to include design work, future improvements and vertical construction projects within the bounds of Finegayan Utilities and Site Improvements Phase 1 at NBGTS.
