Recently Engineer José R. Negrón, contacted our technical personnel to request a description of the applicable rules to the permit granted for the operation of your private sanitary landfill.

About this, we want to inform you that the following permit conditions include all the documents submitted, reviewed and accepted; and the Operating Plan submitted on October 26, 1992.

The proposed Operating Plan contains the controls required to comply with Rule 502 of the Environmental Quality Board (EQB) Non-Hazardous Solid Waste Regulation. The plan includes operating methods to direct and control the use of the area with procedures to spread, classify, compact and landfill non-hazardous solid wastes.

Related to the permit conditions, the following rules apply to the granted permit:

- Rule 302- General prohibitions, permit and EQB regulation compliance.

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- Rule 401.5- Requirements for the control of explosive gases.
- Rule 502- Submission of an operating plan.
- Rule 503- Monitoring, recordkeeping, maintenance of monitoring wells, sampling and testing methods.
- Rule 504- Additional requirements for the maintenance of monitoring wells.
- Rule 602- Applies to operation rules.
- Rule 603- Personnel requirements
- Rule 604- Personnel training
- Rule 605- Equipment requirements
- Rule 606- Additional operating rules
- Rule 701.2- Requirements for monitoring after post-closure.
- Rule 702.4- Ground Water Monitoring must continue after post-closure
- Rule 703- Ground water monitoring plan must be approved by the EQB.
- Rule 704- Design requirements for the ground water monitoring system.

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- Rule 705- Requires the approval by the Board of a Sampling and Analysis Plan.
- Rule 706- Sampling and analysis requirements.
- Rule 708- Detection Monitoring Program.
- Rule 710- Assessment of corrective measures.
- Rule 711- Selection of remedy.
- Rule 712- Implementation of the Corrective Action Program.
- Rule 1003- Permit to operate a Non-Hazardous Solid Waste Facility.
