

Assessment Study Records Search

1. The Naval Energy and Environmental Support Activity (NAVENENVSA) is conducting an Initial Assessment Study (IAS) at the Naval Facilities on the Islands of Puerto Rico, Vieques, and Culebra. The purpose of the Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP) Program is to identify, assess, and control contamination of the environment from past operations. An integral step of the IAS is the review of records pertaining to past environmental contamination, operations, missions, and industrial processes at the activities being surveyed, including the disposal of wastes and by-product materials. It is believed that records in your possession can provide valuable data and information relative to past operations at the activities being surveyed.

2. An environmental consulting firm, Greenleaf-Telesca of Miami, Florida, with its subcontractor Ecology and Environment of Buffalo, New York, is conducting the study under Navy contract N62474-82-C-C357. Personnel from these firms are members of the study team conducting the records search for NAVENENVSA. Your cooperation in permitting the study team to review your files is requested. In addition, the use of photocopying facilities to duplicate unique documents is requested. James Moore of Ecology and Environment will contact your office to make the necessary arrangements for the visit.
