Subject: OUTLINE COMMENTS FOR REGIONAL FEASIBILITY STUDY - GROUNDWATER

Pat called me to inform me that Occidental Chemical did not have any adverse comments regarding the outline for the Regional FS. He did, however, have some suggestions that he would like us to consider when we write the FS. His suggestions were:

- keep the introduction section brief since all of the readers are already pretty knowledgable about the sites and the groundwater contamination problem
- put the ARARs in a Table format in order to make it easier to refer to all of the ARARs that are to be considered
- to put a paragraph within Section 4.3 which outlines the PRPs preferred remedy. This should be done at least for the Draft to inform the State of our preferred option. If the State does not concur, then we can always take it out for the Final.

Pat wanted to know how we are going to handle the TIC issue in this FS. I told him that the TIC guidances are only To Be Considered (TBCs) and that we will identify TBCs and then see how the State goes about regulating the clean up with regards to TICs. If we don't agree with them, then we will have to provide some good justification.
