At the request of the Northrop Grumman Corporation (NGC), the Navy collected air samples from within the Plant 5 building on May 15, 2002. The samples were collected in accordance with a draft workplan that was developed by Dvirka & Bartilucci on behalf of NGC and adopted by the Navy's environmental consultant, Tetra Tech NUS. The workplan was forwarded to New York State Department Health (NYSDOH) on 3 May 2002, along with a copy that was sent to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC).

The air samples have been analyzed and the enclosed report of results is being forwarding for your use.

As discussed, it is the Navy's understanding that any actions that may be required by the New York State DOH or DEC, based on the results of the air sampling analysis, will be the responsibility of NGC.
