Giardina Celebrates 50 Years Of Service

The Hicksville Fire Department recently honored ex-captain Joseph Giardina for his 50 years of service to the local community.

Giardina joined the Hicksville Fire Department in August of 1965, following his military service in the United States Air Force. He had no family history of firefighting and joined the department out of a desire to help others.

"I wanted to help the community," Giardina said on joining the department. "I was a young man and felt it was my obligation."

Over the last five decades, the fire department said Giardina has

set himself apart as an example of service and has served with distinction and honor. He became an officer in 1974 and a captain of Independent Engine and Hose Company Two in 1978. The next year, he was elected treasurer of the company, a position he holds to this day. In 1990, he was elected as fire commissioner for the district. He served for 15 years in that position and worked with numerous chiefs. He said it's the close-knit bond of the department that's kept him involved.

"When you go into burning buildings, you have to become close," he said. "It's a brotherhood, there's a lot of things you do both socially and firefighter-wise...and I really adore all the people I serve with."
