Work Plan for your review and comment. This work plan outlines
planned activities to determine the nature and extent of
contamination at four sites at NWIRP. The specific sites include:

- * Site 1 - Northeast Pond Disposal Area (SWMU 1)
- * Site 2 - Fire Training Area (SWMU 13)
- * Site 6A - Fuel Calibration Area (SWMU 1A)
- * Site 7 - Fuel Depot

The enclosed RFI Work Plan consists of 5 plans:

- Plan A - Data Collection Quality Assurance Project Plan
- Plan B - Project Management Plan
- Plan C - Data Management Plan
- Plan D - Health and Safety Plan
- Plan E - Community Relations Plan

The Work Plan was prepared in accordance with the New York State
RCRA Hazardous Waste Permit (NYSDEC 1-4730-00013/000001-0) and is
also intended to comply with the requirements of a RFI Task III
Report for the USEPA facility permit (EPA ID No. NYD003995198).

Review Committee Meeting is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday,
January 26 at 1:00 PM at NWIRP Calverton. Since the meeting will
