MEMORANDUM

**FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE TECHNICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (TRC) FOR THE INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM AT NAVAL WEAPONS INDUSTRIAL RESERVE PLANT (NWIRP) CALVERTON, NEW YORK**

Enclosed is the Navy's Draft Phase 2 RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) for NWIRP Calverton, NY. This report specifically addresses Site 1 - Northeast Pond Disposal Area, Site 2 - Fire Training Area, and Site 7 - Fuel Depot. Please review the document and forward any comments in writing on or before February 20, 1998.

In addition to the three sites listed above, Phase 2 RFI efforts are continuing at other Installation Restoration (IR) sites. The results from these investigations will be presented in a supplemental Draft Phase 2 RFI Report that will be forwarded under separate correspondence. The purpose of the Phase 2 RFI effort was to gather additional analytical data at all of the IR sites to address data gaps identified in the Phase 1 RFI dated August 1995.


The enclosed document will conclude that the Navy has adequately characterized the nature and extent of soil and groundwater contamination at Sites 1, 2, and 7 and that sufficient analytical data now exists to proceed with the development of a Corrective Measures Study (CMS). The purpose of the CMS will be to evaluate different remedial options for addressing contamination at each of the sites.

Please note that upon finalization of this Phase 2 RFI Report, only Volume I will be forwarded. Therefore, you are asked to retain the draft version of Volume II as these will eventually become the final appendices to the Final Phase 2 RFI Report. If changes to the appendices are required, only those affected pages will be sent to you.
