The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the Draft FY2012 Site Management Plan (SMP) dated October 2012, and received for review by NC Superfund on November 5, 2012. The SMP is in good order. The following comments are included for the Partnering Teams consideration.

**Specific Comments**

1. OU#1, Site 21-Transformer Storage Lot 140 appears to be located in the place of OU#1, Site 78 North. If this is true please clarify that Site 78 North replaced Site 21 in the paragraph on page 8-14 and throughout the report.
2. The Schedule 4-1, for UXO-02, follows Description and Previous investigation Summary for MMRP Site UXO-14, ASR#2.199 and 2.200. A similar disorder occurs for all the schedules in Section 4 and for the UXO-23/21 schedule in Section 5. Please make the appropriate corrections in the final document.
3. The RI/FS schedule for Site UXO-19, Camp Devil Dog, and Schedule 5-3 lists a Draft RI/FS in February 2012. It is November and no RI/FS Reports for this site have been submitted for review. Please rework this schedule with appropriate dates.
4. Based on our discussions at our last partnering meeting, IRP Site 49 was put on hold for a year while additional monitoring is completed. Please make appropriate corrections to Schedule 6-1.
5. Figure 8-21 is labeled as Site 73 Site Management Plan. This is actually a figure of the Site 88 contaminated groundwater plume. Please include the correct Figure for Site 73 in the final SMP document.
6. Under previous Investigation/Action at Site 85 in Table 8-77 on page 8-113 we should include a discussion of the battery pile removal that was completed as part of the recent PA/SI or ESI investigations. This action should be well documented. Some of the battery piles were under tree roots.

7. UXO-20 -1000-inch Range at Montford Point indicates that a NFA was assigned in 2010. I recall that a site or SWMU in this area had LUCs on it. Was that part of Site UXO-20 or another Site within or adjacent to Site UXO-20?
