The Superfund Section of the Division of Waste Management has completed its review of the Technical Memorandum – Summary of Munitions Response Investigation at the MCAS New River Runway Expansion Area Within and Adjacent to Site UXO-29. The 100 % DGM and clearance of the area within the MILCON footprint greatly reduced the potential for encountering MEC and MPPEH during the construction activities. Worker safety is further ensured by conducting 3R's training for personnel working within that area. NCDENR concurs with the conclusions and recommendations that additional MEC and MPPEH may exist within Site UXO-29 outside the boundary of the area that has been cleared for the MILCON project and that this area will be the subject of further investigation and clearance as necessary.
