The NC Superfund Section has received and reviewed the 2015 Five-Year-Review Report for the Camp Lejeune, MCB Superfund Site. The following comments are included for your consideration.

Specific Comments:

1. The units of Groundwater in Table 3-1 should be micrograms per liter rather than milligrams per liter. The soil numbers and units are suspect as well. Make appropriate corrections for the final report.
2. Spelling error. Change the word sero to zero in the fifth bullet on page 15-3.
3. Should we include a statement or paragraph about removal follow-up of PCBs at Site 84 when the utility easement lease comes up for renewal. See Section 16.6 on page 16-4.
4. It is recommended that we use PPM units mg/kg in Table 16-1 rather than PPB units ug/kg. This is the only Site that does not have groundwater contamination.
