Dear Mr. Lucius:

The following is provided in response to your letters regarding the Site Inspection (SI) for the Crash Crew Burn Pit, MCALF Bogue, North Carolina and Site 1, Old Station Landfill, Naval Ordnance Station (NAVORDSTA) Louisville, and the Expanded Site Inspection (ESI) for Site 4, Northeast Corner Liquid Disposal Area, NAVORDSTA Louisville.

According to the Expanded Site Inspection (ESI) Transitional Guidance for FY-88, OSWER Directive 9345.1-02, an ESI should be conducted for only those "sites projected to make the National Priorities List (NPL)". The draft HRS worksheets for Site 4, NAVORDSTA Louisville, which were included in our letter of April 14, 1988, indicated a preliminary HRS score of 7.32. We, therefore, feel that an ESI is not warranted at this time.

Site Inspections are being conducted for all three sites under existing contracts administered by Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command. Considering the time constraints involved with negotiating contract changes and the time necessary to complete the work, the anticipated SI completion date for the two NAVORDSTA Louisville sites is 30 January 1989. The anticipated SI completion date for MCALF Bogue is 28 February 1989.

Information pertaining to the groundwater users in the area of MCALF Bogue and the Site Inspection Trip Report are forwarded as enclosures (1) and (2).

We feel that the SI and groundwater user information for MCALF Bogue and the SI for the two NAVORDSTA Louisville sites will more than satisfy the Navy's requirements set forth in Section 120(d), "Assessment and Evaluation", of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act.
