I have reviewed the above sited document for OU6, Site 12 Crash Crew Training Area and find it acceptable for its intended purpose. The additional investigation activities involve soil and groundwater sampling beneath the former burn pit areas which were not sampled during earlier RI activities. The supplemental data achieved from the sampling will help to further evaluate the nature and extent of contamination at the site, identify potential risks to human health and the environment, and supplement the Draft Final Remedial Investigation (RI) Report (dated June 2002) in the development and evaluation of potential remediation needs. It is our understanding that the results of this investigation will be presented in an appendix as part of the Final RI Report for Operable unit 6, Site 12.
