The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) hereby approves your request to change the bi-monthly Progress Reports into quarterly Progress Reports, with one condition. This condition is that a representative for the facility must notify the U.S. EPA at least two weeks in advance of any field activities associated with the Corrective Action activities. If schedules change, and two weeks notice can not be given, the facility will notify the U.S. EPA as soon as possible, to allow for travel time if the U.S. EPA decides to perform an oversight inspection.

The U.S. EPA also approves the Permittee's request for an extension on the due dates for submission of the RCRA Facility Investigation (RFI) Phase III Ground Water Release Characterization Work Plans for the Pest Control, McComish Gorge, and Old Burn Pit Solid Waste Management Units. This extension allows the Permittee to consolidate these work plans into one submittal. The new due date is August 1, 1991.
