Crane Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center (NAVSURFWARCENDIV) has not received comments concerning the draft RFI Phase I Environmental Monitoring Report (EMR) for Solid Waste Management Units (SWMUs) 14/00 (Sanitary Landfill and Lithium Battery), 15/06 (Roads and Grounds Area), and 16/16 (Cast High Explosive Fill, B-146 Incinerator) submitted to your office on March 17, 1992. NAVSURFWARCENDIV therefore assumes concurrence and is submitting three copies of the final report as enclosure (1).

NAVSURFWARCENDIV also submits three copies of the draft RFI Phase II Workplan for SWMUs 08/17 (Load and Fill Area, B-106 Pond), 12/14 (Mine Fill A), 13/14 (Mine Fill B), and 19/00 (Pyrotechnic Test Areas) as enclosure (2). Enclosure (3) is the required certification statement.
