

DATE: NOVEMBER 16, 1992

TIME: 7:00 PM

1 MR. DEJESUS: Okay, this, uh public hearing is called to order.
2 Uh, this public hearing is, uh, was called upon as a result of the
3 Crane Division Naval, Naval Surface Warfare Center's request to the
4 Environmental Protection, uh Agency, Region 5, uh concerning certain
5 modifications to it's Resource Conservation Recovery Act, Part B
6 Permit. The -- on 21, May, 1992, the Crane Division submitted to the
7 -- a letter to the E.P.A. A request seeking approval to modify the
8 permit to delete the fifth round of groundwater, groundwater sampling
9 required by it's permit. Uh, E.P.A. approved the request, uh on 30,
10 September, 1992. Uh, at the same time the Division submitted other
11 permit modifications, uh to it's permit, uh the summary of these
12 changes are as follows: The name of the facility has changed from Naval
13 Weapons Support Center, as listed in the permit, and the new name is
14 the Crane Division Naval Surface Warfare Center. Uh, the Division also
15 requested, uh okay, okay, the Division also requested to amend it's
16 records to reflect that in operations in Building 1884 were recently
17 identified as generating FC19 Waste, uh that's waste water treatment
18 sludges from the chemical conversion coating of aluminum. The sludges
19 from this operation have been handled as hazardous waste in the past,
20 therefore it is essentially a documentation change as it does not
21 effect handling or disposing methods of the sludge. Uh, as previously
22 stated the deletion of fifth round of groundwater sampling, the
23 Division's RCRA Permit, require 5 ounces of groundwater sampling at the
24 Dye Burial Grounds, Demolition Range, Old Rifle Range and Rockeye Solid
25 Waste Management Units as part of the Correction, Corrective Action
26 Program. Four rounds of sampling were completed by the Army Core of

1 Engineers for the Division and it was felt that the fifth round not,
2 not necessary. Uh, deletion of the last round require a permit
3 modification with the (indiscernible) of the U.S. E.P.A., uh regional
4 director, not commissioner. Crane submitted a letter to the E.P.A. on
5 21, May, 1992, requesting approval to modify their permit and delete
6 the fifth round based on the Navy's belief that depending on the
7 specific statistical analysis chosen four rounds of sampling are
8 satisfactory for performing statistical analysis. Uh, a new building
9 of 2993, the Division designated and built a new storage building at
10 the Building 2993 Waste Storage Area. Before any waste can be stored
11 in the building the permit has to be modified, thereby getting the U.S.
12 E.P.A.'s and Indiana Department of Environmental Agency approval for
13 use. The building will be used for storing waste that do not require
14 climate controls as none was included in the design or construction.
15 Permission to use the building is sought on the bases that A) The
16 structure was designed and built to meet E.P.A.'s storage requirements,
17 B) The building is essential for maintaining adequate aisle space among
18 rooms without double stacking of drums and C) Use of the building does
19 not increase the volume of waste management the facility as listed in
20 Section 5 of the permit. Compressed Gas Cylinder Site, the Division is
21 requesting a decision from the E.P.A. that final cleanup has been
22 completed on Solid Waste Management, Unit 31/00, the Compressed Gas
23 Cylinder Site. As such, Crane is requesting a permit modification to
24 remove the site from the Corrective Acting Schedule. A total of 41
25 Compressed Gas Cylinders were removed during an interim measures
26 cleanup on 4, August, 1990. A visual inspection of the site after the

1 removal the cylinders, cylinders indicated that there was no soil
2 contamination present. Some potential contaminants were in a gaseous
3 state, no contamination of surface waters, groundwater, or solid would
4 be expected. These are the summary of the changes that are being
5 sought, uh, uh as modifications to it's permit. At this time I will
6 ask anybody who has any comments on the request for modifications to
7 come forward and make any such comments for inclusion into the record.
8 Nobody coming forward we will recess for 15 minutes and give anybody
9 else or anybody who may be interested in coming forward the chance to
10 make themselves known.

11 OFF THE RECORD

12 MR. DEJESUS: For purposes of additional background the Division
13 notified the persons on the facility's mailing list, uh list provided
14 by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management of the Permit
15 Modification Request and this was done in writing by a letter dated 14,
16 October, 1992. Uh, notification of the Federal Permit Modification
17 Request was published in the Bedford Times Mail on October 19th, 1992.
18 This notification started a sixty day public comment period commencing
19 on December 18, 1992. E.P.A. regulations require public hearing no
20 sooner than fifteen days after the notification and no later than
21 fifteen days prior to the close of the comment period, therefore the
22 hearing was set for today, uh 16th of November, 1992, at the Bedford
23 City Hall at 7:00 pm. Uh, the Indiana Department of Environmental
24 Management called on 27, October, 1992, stating that the Division would
25 also need to modify the State Permit with regard to the facility's name
26 change, the FO19 Waste Code and the new structure. The groundwater

1 sampling rounds and the Compressed Gas Cylinder Site are solely covered
2 under the Federal Permit, as a result of that the Division sent letters
3 dated 22, October, 1992, concerning the State Permit Modifications to
4 the Indiana Department of Environmental Management and the facility
5 mailing list, the people who were previously notified. Notification of
6 the State Permit Modification was published on the 26th, October, 1992,
7 Bedford Times Mail issue. This did not effect the date of the public
8 hearing, but extended the closing date of the sixty day comment period
9 to December 25th, 1992. December 28th chosen as closing date for
10 comments; that's because the 25th is a federal holiday, right, okay.
11 Uh, since nobody has come forward, uh I declare this hearing closed
12 then at 7:17 pm.

13 OFF THE RECORD

14 MR. DEJESUS: Just an amendment to the hearing, uh for purposes of
15 the, the record, uh the record should reflect that Mr. Jim Hunsicker,
16 an Environmental Manager for the Crane Division Naval Surface Warfare
17 Center, Code 095, is present. Additionally, Mr. Thomas J. Brent, an
18 Environmental Protection Specialist for the Crane Division is -- and
19 also from Code 095 is also present.




