You are hereby notified that the Indiana Department of Environmental Management has approved the modification plans and specifications submitted to this office on April 29, 1996, for the above-referenced solid waste management facility. The issuance of this modification does not supersede the requirements of any other agency of local, State or federal government.

The project consists of reducing the permitted acreage for waste disposal at the facility by approximately 5.3 acres. These acres will no longer be available for solid waste disposal. The solid waste facility referenced above is located at Crane Naval Center and contains approximately 15 acres permitted for landfilling.


Crane Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center is hereby certified as having completed the requirements for a modification in accordance with IC 36-9-30 and 13-7, and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder. Therefore, the modification is hereby approved subject to the terms and conditions of this letter and the enclosed requirements.

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Pursuant to IC 4-21.5, a Petition for Review of this permit modification letter may be initiated by you, as applicant, or by an "aggrieved or adversely affected person". This permit modification becomes effective once all applicable time periods for petitioning for Stays of Effectiveness have expired, unless you are notified in writing by an Environmental Law Judge that the permit modification has been further stayed. As discussed in our enclosed Notice of Decision, if you wish to challenge this decision, you must file a Petition for Review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication within eighteen (18) days from the date that this permit modification letter was mailed, pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-7.

## NOTICE OF DECISION


### Indiana Department of Environmental Management

You are hereby notified that the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Office of Solid and Hazardous Waste Management, has issued a solid waste facility minor modification for the Crane Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center Landfill which is located at Crane Naval Center, in Martin County. This project will reduce the permitted acreage for waste disposal at the facility by approximately 5.3 acres. These acres will no longer be available for solid waste disposal. A copy of this permit is available for review at the Shoals Public Library located in Shoals, Indiana

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that a petition for administrative review be filed. This petition describing your intent must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, ISTA Building, 150 W. Market Street, Suite 618, Indianapolis, IN 46204, within eighteen (18) days from the mailing of this notice. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing: (1) The date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA), (2) The date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail, or (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by the receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier. In order to assist the permit staff in tracking appeals, we request that you submit a copy of your petition to Mr. Bill Holland, Solid Waste Facilities Branch, at 100 N. Senate Ave., P.O. Box 6015, Indianapolis, Indiana 46206. This petition must include facts demonstrating that the petitioner is the applicant, a person aggrieved by the decision, or a person entitled to review by law. Identifying the permit decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, or date of this notice, will expedite review of the petition.

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(d), the Office of Environmental Adjudication will provide the petitioner or any person requesting notice with notice of prehearing conferences, preliminary hearings, hearing stays or orders disposing of the petition for review if a written request for such notice is submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication at the above address. If you have procedural or scheduling questions regarding your petition, you may contact OEA at (317) 232-8591. Questions regarding the technical aspects of the permit decision should be directed to Mr. Bill Holland at (317) 233-0449.
