The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has reviewed the FAX information dated June 5, 1996, regarding the proposed plan to finish excavating remaining soil contamination at Highway 58 Dumpsite B (SWMU 26/08D). The grid demarcation is satisfactory. I agree that soil samples will not be taken at areas that the soil is removed to the bedrock. In areas where soil is left from the excavation, a composite approach is satisfactory in this site-specific case. Please make sure that the perimeter is confirmed as being clean in the final testing.

Please document the final excavation grades. When all field and laboratory analyses are completed, the contractor should prepare a draft Interim Measures Report for review by the Agency. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact me at (312) 886-6146.
