The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) hereby approves the final report: Geophysical Investigation at SWMUs 14/00 and 17/04, dated December 1995. The geophysical data was used to support further Interim Measures to remove both units. The Lithium Batteries were removed from their location and properly treated. The PCB capacitors were not able to be located based on the geophysical results. The Interim Measure reports should be referenced for any further information.
