A review of your proposed insignificant facility modification proposal received December 9, 1999, has been completed. Your proposal to use composted soils as daily cover is denied. The Crane Division needs to obtain a special waste certification to demonstrate that the composted, treated soils are appropriate for disposal at this landfill before a decision can be made on alternative daily cover. The analytical testing submitted was not complete and lacked the proper quality assurance documentation.
