The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) hereby approves the Final Draft Interim Measures Report for Solid Waste Management Unit (SWMU) 23/00: Battery Shop dated January 2000. The report revealed that the soil at the SWMU contains metals and pesticides at levels above the Interim Measures cleanup levels.

The U.S. Navy is currently scheduled and funded for a multimedia RCRA Facility Investigation to determine the presence and extent of remaining contamination at this SWMU.
