The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has received and hereby approves the U.S. Navy's request for a Class 1 modification to the Final Open Burning Open Detonation (OB/OD) Hazardous Waste Management Permit dated January 13, 2000.

This modification updates the following Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) in Volume II of the Final Quality Assurance Project Plan for groundwater monitoring at the OB/OD units: LTL-1001 (Elements of SOP and Method Formats), LTL-1004 (Documentation of Analyst Competence and Training), LTL-1012 (Solvent QC Monitoring for Trace Residue Analysis), LTL-4002 (Electronic Sample Entry and Log-In), LTL-7202 (Metals Analysis Using Inductively Coupled Plasma - Mass Spectrometry - SW846 Method 6020), LTL-8081 (Analysis of Organochlorine Pesticides/PCBs by Method 8081), and LTL-8276 (Determination of Semivolatile Organic Compounds by Method SW 8260B).

The U.S. Navy will notify persons on the facility mailing list within 90 calendar days after the receipt of this letter in accordance with 40 Code of Federal Regulations 270.42(a)(ii).
