Subj: RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD (RAB) MEETING AGENDA

This is a reminder that the Crane Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center (NAVSURFWARCENDIV Crane) RAB meeting is scheduled for 12:00 to 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 14, 2000. The meeting will take place on Center in the main dining room of the Lakeview Training and Conference Center.

Because this meeting has been scheduled for the afternoon, it is hoped that more interested parties will be able to attend due to reduced conflict with after work activities. RAB meetings are open to members of the public and are intended to help the general public learn how NAVSURFWARCENDIV Crane is conducting environmental cleanups using proven and alternative technologies. The RAB at Crane is a forum for exchange of information and partnership among citizens of the surrounding communities with DoD, and environmental oversight agencies. Most importantly, the RAB will offer an opportunity for the communities to provide input to the cleanup process. The goal is to create a dialogue between the installation and the effected communities.

Also, since the meeting coincides with the afternoon meal, a working lunch has been planned. The meal will consist of Lasagna, a side salad, garlic breadsticks, and a cookie served with coffee or tea. The cost of the meal will be \$7.00, gratuity is included; other beverages are extra. Please make your reservation by November 2, 2000. If you make a reservation and cannot attend the luncheon, please call and cancel.

The agenda for the meeting will include, status updates on current and proposed Corrective Action activities including the Explosives Contaminated Soils Bioremediation Facility, Soils Background Study, Mine Fill A Battery Dump Site, and Roads & Grounds Cleanup. A presentation, discussion, and RAB member vote will be held concerning the RAB website. RAB officials will also sign the RAB Charter reducing the number of RAB meetings to twice a year and updating the member listing in Appendix 1. The annual Environmental Restoration, Navy project Budgets for procured for Fiscal Year (FY) 01 and proposed for FY 02 will be presented and discussed. Finally, plaques will be presented to the winning members of the Chief of Naval Operations Fiscal Year 99 Annual Environmental Security Award for the Environmental Cleanup Team award for their effort in the Bioremediation Facility Operations.
