In response to the issue concerning RDX in Little Sulphur Creek, Crane Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center (NSWC Crane) submits a CD containing an ArcView Project, "rdx-lsc.apr" and associated shapefiles as enclosure (1). Please review the Word Document on the CD, titled "RDX LSC CD Info" first, as it contains explanatory notes for the ArcView project. A plat of the same area is provided on the CD. In response to the U. S. EPA's question as to whether or not there are drinking water intakes along Little Sulphur Creek, a review of Indiana Public Water System Database (www.ai.org/serv/idem/dwb/inventory) shows there are no permitted public surface water intakes along or below Little Sulphur Creek in Martin County, Indiana. The permit required Certification Statement is provided as enclosure (2).
