RESPONSE TO THE FINAL EPA COMMENT ON THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (SB) FOR NAVAL SURFACE WARFARE CENTER (NSWC) CRANE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT UNIT (SWMU) 2, DYE BURIAL GROUNDS (DBG)

Comment (paraphrased):

The only remaining comment is a request to include additional locations of available information related to SWMU 2. For example, under Public Participation, include the additional information repositories at IDEM and Crane (are files kept at Crane available for public access?) and Crane's RAB web site URL.

Please include a notice of a one month comment period with instructions to send written comments to Peter Ramanauskas by mail or email. The SB should be sent to all on the Crane mailing list. This info/statement of basis should also be posted on Crane's web site. Is it possible to put electronic versions of documents related to this SWMU on the web-site (available for download - text only, to limit file size or limited figures to keep size down)?
