**Bill and Tom** – Per our discussion the electronic version of the final plan for sampling south of SWMU 8 B106 is enclosed.

**Dave** – As we discussed fieldwork is scheduled to start the week of September 25, 2006. Fieldwork will be taking place in coordination with fieldwork at SWMUs 9 and 17. The samples will be collected by DPT. Roger Clark and Jeff Schubert are taking care of the procurement process for DPT services.
