The Indiana Department of Environmental Management has reviewed the No Further Action proposal for Solid Waste Management Unit 15 (Roads and Grounds) and agrees with the Navy's conclusion that there would be no net benefit to human health and the environment from any remedial action.

The No Further Action determination is not final until the facility's operating permit has been modified. Crane may submit a Class 1 permit modification request outlining the proposed changes to the language in the permit conditions and in the SWMU summary in Attachment VIII. The Class 1 modification request should briefly outline the reason for the change and reference the RFI Report for details.
