RE: NOTIFICATION CONCERNING AN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT TO BE UNDERTAKEN
IN THE WAYSIDE AREA OF NAVAL WEAPONS STATION EARLE

Gentlemen:

It has come to my attention that a potential environmental problem exists in the "Wayside" area of Naval Weapons Station Earle.

On the basis of a preliminary site inspection, we have determined that the possibility exists that parts of the Wayside area may require an environmental assessment. Items of concern include electrical transformers, aboveground and underground storage tanks. This area has been closed to all personnel.

In accordance with the Federal Facilities Agreement, you are hereby notified that this condition exists, and that an environmental assessment/study will be conducted to determine the potential threat, if any, to that area of the Station.

I request any input you can offer to assure that all actions are properly taken to render this site "clean" from an environmental perspective.
