This letter is in reference to the Site Inspection Report for Site 8 that was sent to you via Weston on 31 October 1991. As described in the Summary and Conclusions to the Report, the data demonstrates that no further investigations are necessary and that no remedial action is required at Site 8.

As discussed on 19 November 1991, the Navy is now moving forward with plans to construct an asphalt parking lot on the site. The construction of the parking lot could begin as soon as Spring, 1992. If EPA Region II or NJDEP have any technical comments or concerns, please advise us in 30 days in order to keep the construction project on schedule.
