Dear Mr. Freudenberg:

Section 1.3 of the Draft Site Inspection Report dated February 1993 states the following:

"Two sites (Site 14, the Defense Property Disposal Office Warehouse; and Site 28, the Waste Oil Tank (Building C-16), have been excluded from the current SI effort because both sites have been addressed under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). Cleanup efforts were conducted at Site 14 and Site 28 has undergone a state-approved closure which included removal of the tank and groundwater monitoring. The RCRA site inspection report recommends no further action at either site."

Could you please furnish me with a copy of the state-approved closure plan and groundwater monitoring data, the RCRA site inspection report and any other information you may have dealing with these two sites.
