The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is finalizing the review of the Site Inspection (SI) Report. Also, as a result of the February 18, 1993 conference call, I am concerned that Weston may not have addressed all of EPA's comments on the SI Workplan and I will have to go back and check this. Finally, before no further action is deemed appropriate at Sites 29 and C, a visual inspection must be conducted by EPA.

Therefore, EPA can not agree just yet that no further action is warranted at Sites 29 and C.
