

MINUTES FOR TRC MEETING
OF JUNE 3, 1993
NAVAL WEAPONS STATION (NWS)
EARLE, NEW JERSEY

1. The meeting was opened shortly after 10:00 by Mr. John Kolicius, the Remedial Project Manager for NWS Earle. Introductions were followed by a brief discussion of the February meeting. Mr. Kolicius then indicated that the Navy was going to replace Weston as its contractor following completion of assigned tasks. LCDR Dell then indicated that this would be his last meeting because he was being re-assigned to Japan.

2. Mr. John Williams from Weston summarized efforts to finalize the Remedial Investigation (RI) and Site Investigation (SI) reports. He stated that the RI comments were being addressed, but he was still awaiting some comments on the SI. Mr. Kolicius said that some comments which related to both the RI and SI would require additional fieldwork which would be completed under the next phase of the investigation. Mr. Joe Freudenberg from the New Jersey Dept. of Environmental Protection and Energy (DEPE) asked if he would be getting specific responses to DEPE's comments before the RI report is finalized. Mr. Williams indicated that DEPE's comments were being addressed in the report. Mr. Kolicius instructed Mr. Williams to provide separate responses.

3. Mr. Kolicius discussed that a site visit was conducted on May 20, 1993 with EPA and New Jersey representatives as a follow-up to the Preliminary Assessment for the 17 "EPIC" sites". Site F, the C-50 Roundhouse Area, was recommended for further action in the PA Report. As a result of the site visit Sites L and Q will also proceed to an SI. Site G has been re-activated as a pistol range, so any investigation there will be deferred until closure.

4. The next meeting of the Technical Review Committee was scheduled for Tuesday, August 3, 1993 at 10:00 AM in the Public Works Conference Room in Building C-29 at NWS Earle.
