Dear Mr. Koliccius:

As a result of reviewing the Remedial Investigation (RI) Report, it has been noted that some discrepancies exist with regard to the reported Volatile Organic data. Specifically, the issue is that the RI Report contains data tables with both high concentration positive results and routine detection limits listed, without any mention of sample dilution factors. In order to verify that the Weston Lab performed the necessary sample analyses (dilutions and straight runs) to support the reported data, a data audit has been requested.

The following information needs to be obtained from the Weston Lab: a list of samples with the associated date of analysis, and a CLP equivalent data package for the samples undergoing the audit (including multiple runs for a single sample if that sample underwent any dilutions).
