Three copies of the "Remedial Investigation/ Feasibility Study For 11 Sites at NWS Earle, Colts Neck, NJ" are enclosed. This report concludes work on these sites by our previous contractor, Weston. As discussed, a Phase II RI/FS will be conducted by our new contractor, HALLIBURTON NUS to fill previously defined data gaps.

Areas of concern which will be addressed in the Phase II RI/FS include horizontal and vertical extent of contaminant migration, definition of background levels, site grouping, watershed-based risks and data validity. Any input you can provide during preparation of the scope of work for this phase will help to satisfy everyone's needs in the investigation. A draft of the scope will be forwarded to you for review prior to issuance.
