NAVAL WEAPONS STATION EARLE COLTS NECK, NEW JERSEY

This announces that an Action Memorandum, Engineering Evaluation and Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for a Removal Action of blasting grit and any impacted soil at NWS Earle Site 20 under the Navy's Installation Restoration Program has been drafted. The Northern Division of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command, the lead agency for site remedial activity, has recommended removal of old blasting grit and related impacted soil to minimize any potential threat to the wetlands northeast of Site 20. The approach involves excavating the blasting grit pile and any impacted soils, then recycling it, or, alternatively, disposing of it in a RCRA permitted landfill if it is found unsuitable for recycling. NWS Earle will consider written and verbal comments on all the proposed alternatives before final selection of the remedial alternative and issuance of a Decision Document reflecting this choice. Written comments must be postmarked on or before November 10, 1994.
