Dear Mr. Gratz:

This letter is to confirm the agreements made during our meeting on April 20, 1995 at NWS Earle. In addition to the 4/5 NJDEP which I have addressed in a separate letter, we agree to the following conditions to acceptance of the work plan.

- * All tables will be modified to reflect the contingencies noted in the text.
- * CERCLA QA/QC protocols will take priority over NJDEP protocols.
- * NJDEP specifications for shallow water table monitoring well will be implemented where appropriate.
- * One week notice will be provided to allow arrangements for oversight of significant field activities.

Your agreement to allow initiation of field work while the work plan is being finalized is appreciated. The Navy will ensure applicable sections of the plan are finalized and distributed prior to the start of related field activities. Formal issuance of the final workplan will follow as soon as possible. If any other issues come up, please call me at (610) 595-0567 Ext. 157.
