This correspondence is to memorialize the agreement reached in the field between representatives of NorthDiv, Earle and the NJDEP, regarding soil sampling around a UST, which is located along the eastern side of Building C-50. This UST will be retrofitted sometime in the near future. It is noted that this UST is located in an "essential service area" and if any drilling disrupted electrical, gas or heating oil services to Building C-50, this could interrupt the basic mission of Earle Naval Weapons Station. Therefore, when further maintenance/retrofitting is planned for this UST, soil borings will be done at that time.
