

**MINUTES FOR TRC MEETING
OF AUGUST 30, 1995
NAVAL WEAPONS STATION (NWS) EARLE
COLTS NECK, NEW JERSEY**

1. The meeting was opened at 10:00 AM by Mr. J. Kolicius, the Remedial Project Manager for NWS Earle.
2. Mr Kolicius reviewed deviations to the RI Work Plan which included the following:
 - collection of additional surface water & sediment samples at the two Shark River sampling locations for PCB analysis. Mr. Kolicius explained that no PCB's were detected and that the analysis was conducted as a result of an inquiry made to Monmouth County Health Department (MCHD) by Bel Ray Racing Lubricants as to whether or not NWS Earle may have contributed to PCB contamination on the company's nearby property.
 - collection of filtered ground water samples for metals analysis for wells where unfiltered samples exhibited high turbidity. Mr. Kolicius indicated that the majority of samples collected at NWS Earle did not require filtration as a result of the "low flow" sampling technique that was employed.
 - installation of two monitoring wells at Site 29. This was in response to the closure of former wells which were interfering with the construction of the new hazardous waste storage facility on Saipan Road.
 - Mr. Kolicius discussed the discovery of "free phase" petroleum product in two wells at Site 16/F and indicated that the Navy would utilize the new Site Characterization and Analysis Penetrometer System (SCAPS) to delineate the vertical & horizontal extent of the petroleum product in the area. Mr. Kolicius indicated that this system would arrive on site in late September or early October 1995.
3. Mr. Kolicius discussed merging of the TRC working group with the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB). He indicated that this would improve the flow of information among all concerned parties. It was proposed that TRC members become a technical subcommittee of the RAB and meet on an as needed basis to discuss or resolve time critical technical issues versus regularly scheduled meetings. Minutes of any subcommittee meetings would be distributed or discussed during the next quarterly RAB meeting.
4. Mr. Geopfert of NWS Earle proposed revising the RAB Charter to include the technical subcommittee group. Technical subcommittee members would not have to attend every RAB meeting or risk losing RAB membership. Mr. Geopfert indicated that this proposal would be discussed with RAB members during the next RAB meeting scheduled for 5 October 1995.

5. Mr. Kolocius indicated that validated data for all sites with the exception of Sites 9, 14, 22, 27, L and Q would be available the first week of November 1995 and that subsequent meetings among TRC/technical subcommittee members should focus on prioritization of future site remedial actions.

6. The next TRC meeting was tentatively scheduled for 9 November 1995 at Building C-54, NWS Earle at 10:00am. The meeting adjourned at 12:30pm.
