On Thursday evening, 24 Apr 97, Navy representatives were prepared to address the public at the Colts Neck court house at 7:00 P.M. regarding the Proposed Plans for Installation Restoration Sites 4, 5 (landfills) and Site 19 (MK8 Ordnance stripping area). The plan is to design and construct an impermeable cap for the landfill sites, and perform a soil removal action at Site 19.

The only member of the public in official attendance was Mr. Lester Jargowsky of the Monmouth County Health Dept. Mr. Jargowsky stated that "he was pleased with the cooperation the Navy has demonstrated with the regulatory agencies."

At about 7:40 P.M. the meeting was adjourned.
