This announces that an Ac-
tion Memorandum, Engi-
neering Evaluation and Cost
Analysis (EE/CA) for the
excavation and removal of
pipe, sludge and concrete at
the Naval Weapons Station
Earle Site 26 under the
Navy's Installation Restora-
tion Program has been draft-
ed. The Northern Division
of the Naval Facilities Engi-
neering Command, the lead
agency for the site remedial
activity, has recommended
the removal of piping in
ground concrete tanks and
sludge associated with the
former leaching system at
Building GB-01 due to past
disposal practices in order
to minimize the potential
additional migration of solvent
components to the ground-
water. The remedial alterna-
tive involves the excavation
of the concrete tanks, piping
and sludge inside the tanks
for off-site disposal. No post
excavation sampling will be
conducted because the final
remedy for the area shall be
air sparging/soil vapor ex-
traction. Naval Weapons Sta-
tion Earle will consider writ-
ten and verbal comments on
all the proposed alternatives
before final selection of the
remedial alternative and the
issuance of a Decision Docu-
ment reflecting this choice.
